

#### **Report of the Socio Economic Survey**

Department of Economics, Tangla College conducted a socio Economic survey in Uttarkuchi, Amguri and Belguri villages in the Subankhata area of Baksa and Nalbari district Indo-Bhutan border (Chowki Gate) on 03-02-2021. The students conducted the survey by collecting data through predesigned questionnaire from household survey. 50 sample households were selected randomly for this purpose.

There were 249 populations in the simple household where 93 were male & 156 were female. Children population were 66 & the no. of old people were 6. It was found that working population was 177 it les then 1/3 population were dependent population. Out of the simple households 30% were joint 70% were unitary family. Major sources of livelihood of the people were agriculture and agriculture labourer. There were only a few persons engaged in Govt. & private & trading. 665 of the residential houses were made of bamboo hut & 34 houses were of Assam type. Monthly income of 24% households were below Rupees 5000.00, 24% households' monthly income were below Rs. 10,000.00, 18% households were of below Rs. 20,000.00, and 42% households' monthly income were above Rs. 20,000.00. 90% households depended on public tap for the sources of drinking water where as 3% of households depended on own tube well, & 6% of households' collected drinking water from river. It was to be mentioned that the villages were located on the both sides of river Diring. 99% household had electricity for power supply, only one 1% household dependent on kerosene for the source of lighting. It was also found that 50% households have sanitary latrine (Provided by Govt.) & 50% used ordinary latrine. 36% households had LPG connection and 64% household used firewood as fuel. Out of the total household assets 42% had TV, 78% had Mobile phone, 90% households had bicycle and 18% household had motor bike. Only 42% households had BPL cards, and 42% households were indebted and took loan from informal sources. 42% households were benefited from Antodaya Anna Yojana, 6% household was benefited from Ujjala Scheme & 12% households were benefited from Anamaya Scheme of the Govt.

Regarding the educational status, it was found that out of total population of the villages 15% were illiterate, 24% were in primary level, 45% were high school level, 7% were H.S.L.C. passed and only 2% were graduate & others were minor children There were 1 Primary School 1 High School near the villages. 1 non provincialized college was located about 5km distance & another one was located about 15km distance from the villages. There was 1 hospital and 1 post office about 4 km far from the villages. The population of the villages were Bodo, Nepali and Assamese and all of them were Hindu.
